

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE MEETING OF THE STATE LEVEL SANCTIONING COMMITTEE OF RASHTRIYA KRISHI VIKAS YOJNA (RKVY) HELD ON 28.8.2009 AT 12.30 PM UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF SHRI DHARAM VIR, IAS, CHIEF SECRETARY, HARYANA IN THE MAIN COMMITTEE ROOM, HARYANA CIVIL SECRETARIAT, CHANDIGARH.**

List of participants is given in the Annexure.

2. The Financial Commissioner & Principal Secretary to Govt. Haryana, Agriculture Department (FCA) welcomed the Chairman and other participants to the meeting. He informed that the State was reeling under drought like situation and therefore, the meeting of State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) at a short notice was necessitated to take up special projects for mitigating the impact of drought in the state. FCA further informed that Govt. of India had enhanced the allocation under RKVY to Rs. 112.77 crore from the earlier allocation of Rs. 96.91 crore for the year 2009-10. He informed that some specific projects had been formulated to cope up with the drought like situation in the State. Following agenda-wise decisions were taken in the meeting :

**Agenda No.1**

**Confirmation of the proceedings of the meeting of the State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) held on 3.7.2009.**

SLSC was informed that the proceedings of the last meeting held on 3.7.2009 were circulated to all concerned vide letter no. 1743-1767/ TA (RKVY) dated 22.7.2009. Since no comments were received from any quarter, the proceedings of the last meeting were confirmed.

**Agenda No.2:**

**Action Taken Report on the meeting of the State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) held on 3.7.2009.**

SLSC was informed that the Action Taken Report on the decisions of the last meeting of the Committee could not be prepared as the meeting has to be convened at a short notice due to drought like conditions in the State and therefore, the Action Taken Report would be put up before the SLSC in the next meeting.

**Agenda No. 3      Review of release of funds under the RKYV during  
2009-10.**

FCA informed that against the earlier allocation of Rs. 96.91 crore, the Govt. of India had released 50% of the funds as first installment i.e. an amount of Rs.36.35 crore under stream-I and Rs.12.11 crore under stream-II. Further, an amount of Rs. 0.79 crore pertaining to the year 2008-09 had also been revalidated by the Govt. of India. Thus, an amount of Rs.49.25 crore had been released so far. However, there was a wide variation in the project wise approval of funds by SLSC and the sanction received from GOI. This issue had been taken up with GOI for reconciliation of the same. Project wise funds approved by SLSC and amount approved to be released out of the 50% release from GOI was as under:-
